Policies of heritage and landscape preservation in Italy and in France. 1790-1996. Institutions and the management of listed buildings and sites: the case-study of the alpine border

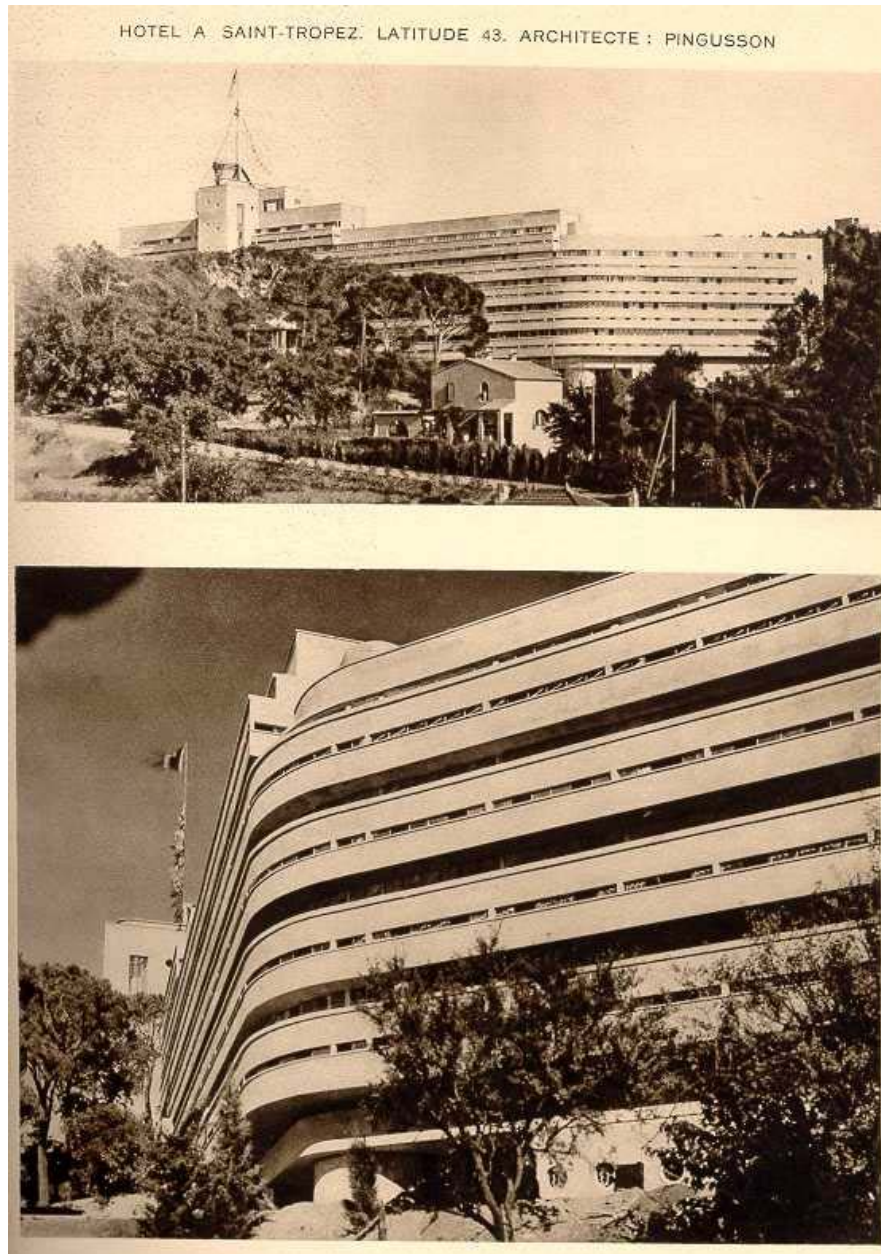

The aim of this research work is to provide a reference on the development of the administrative practice and of the laws concerning heritage and environment preservation in France and Italy, since their first establishment, during the French Revolution, till the most recent European debates.

The history of ideas and cultural battles, of the public acts which were their result, of the new professional sectors they contributed to create, are outlined through an historical analysis and the results in the practice of heritage protection are examined in the contemporary situation of the alpine area in both countries.
